

REV. KRISTINA HANSEN

The Rev. Kristina Hansen is a second career pastor, leaving corporate life to heed a call to ministry in 2000. She attended Union Theological Seminary, graduating in 2003. She was commissioned in 2004 and ordained in 2007.

Kristina's student pastorate, as Children's Minister at St. Paul & St. Andrew on the Upper West Side of Manhattan, began the Sunday after 9/11, where she quickly learned the complexities of children's spiritual formation and care during times of trauma.

In 2003, Kristina was appointed to a three point charge in the Catskill-Hudson region where the churches of Grand Gorge, Gilboa and Conesville graciously received and groomed a newly minted seminarian.

In 2006, she was appointed to Woodbury, Connecticut, where she shepherded the church through a time of crisis.

In 2010, she was appointed to St. Paul's UMC in Northport, NY on Long Island where she has served for the past eight years. During this time she guided the congregation through the process to become a Reconciling Church, open and affirming of LGBTQI persons, established new ministries for adults and children, and led stewardship initiatives that have provided greater financial stability and more abundant ministry.

Beyond the local church, Kristina previously served as Co-chair of the Episcopacy Committee and Chair of the Conference Mission and Vision Table. She currently serves on the NYAC Board of Ordained Ministry, the Board of Directors for United Methodist Frontier Foundation, on the District Committee on Ministry, and as a Cluster Leader, a Clergy Transitional Leader and a Clergy Mentor. She is active in Interfaith ministries and is regularly asked to preach and pray at town-wide events.

After eighteen years in ministry, she is still passionate about church growth, worship leadership, disciple growing, ministry to and with the community, faith formation of children, and mentoring people on their spiritual journey. Kristina and her spouse, Leslie, are avid long distance hikers and devoted Methodists.

A SPECIAL OPPORTUNITY TO MEET PASTOR KRISTINA AND LESLIE in advance of Pastor Kristina's appointment will be held on Tuesday, May 15 at 7 – 8:30 p.m. in Dodd Hall. Pastors Brian and Kristina are working out the design for the evening based on positive pastoral transition events of which they have both been a part. We hope you will make every effort to join this special time. After Pastor Kristina's appointment begins on July 1st, a series of smaller "cottage meetings" will be offered, coordinated by the Staff-Parish Relations Committee, to provide more personal opportunities to meet Pastor Kristina and Leslie. We hope you will attend one of these, too! Those MTMUMC members here in the summer of 2012 will remember similar meetings for Pastor Brian and Carol upon their arrival.

DODD HALL REAR DOOR CHANGES

Based on the recommendation of the Church Security Task Force and the endorsement of the Church Council at their January 18 meeting that the back door to Dodd Hall be an emergency exit only door, the Trustees have taken the necessary steps to permanently convert this door to an "emergency exit door only." In so doing, an alarm was installed on this door so that if it is opened either from the inside or the outside **an alarm will now sound.**

The signage associated with the door has also been updated to reflect the updated status of the door as an emergency exit only door. With this move the Trustees also had the outside cylinder changed so people can no longer enter this door using their church key. Should you trip the alarm by mistake, a key is located in the kitchen next to the stove hanging on a red wooden dowel.
